Community Impact Council Volunteers Needed


Every year, the United Way makes funds available to local programs and organizations through an application process. Funds are granted in December that benefit the northern Idaho **ALICE** population.

UWNI seeks additional volunteers for the **3 Impact Councils** to help decide and review the applications — and keep tabs afterwards to see how things are going.

WHEN: A burst of activity takes place in Oct. and Nov. which involves both group video/remote meetings and site visits of applicants. Mid-year (July) and end-of-year (Jan.) reports are reviewed online.

Responsibilities of an Impact Council volunteer:

- Active and timely participation in the application reviews, discussions/ deliberations
- Share your knowledge and relative experiences; insights from research and assessments
- Maintain independence and objectivity
- · Disclose conflicts of interest
- Maintain confidentiality
